Application: Once dyeing has been carried out and allowed to dry, simply apply a

coating of Dye-Fix with cotton wool or a lint-free cloth to the leather. Once

dry the leather can be finished in the normal way.

Packages: 150ml Plastic Bottles

Storage: Dry, cool conditions.

Handling: No special precautions required. Practise good standards of industrial and

personal hygiene.

Spillage: Contain spillages. Do not let the liquid drain into rivers, ponds or sewer

systems. Small spillages may be hosed down with water before it dries,

subject to Local Water Authority permitting.

FIRST AID TREATMENT
